

# TBU President's Report February 8, 2019 – Council

I hope everyone has been enjoying the crazy weather we have been having. Semester 1 ended with bus cancellations on exam day and Semester 2 started the same way. Hopefully, the weather will start improving now that we made it through January!

As you are aware, the Ford Government has already announced cuts to the Universities and Colleges. Shortly thereafter, the Ministry of Education invited education partners to provide input into questions re: **Class Size Engagement and Ontario School Board Hiring Practices**.

While many of the recent announcements appear elementary focused, we have to remember that although we have class size caps in our collective agreements, the staffing generation ratio is 22/1 in the regulations. If the government changes the ratio to 23/1 it would mean a significant drop in the funding. Many of the specialized programs could be in jeopardy.

Additionally, Regulation 274 which emphasizes seniority and qualifications based hiring is under fire. While there may be some limitations which need to be adjusted, it is important that the essence of Reg. 274 remains intact as it prevents hiring based on nepotism and other types of favouritism.

The Ministry of Education consultation will close February 27<sup>th</sup>. Members are encouraged to complete the consultation surveys, but DO NOT complete the separate guiding questions.
